Come in to view this season's feature exhibit, which explores how Muskoka's wilderness has been used, & sometimes abused, through time.

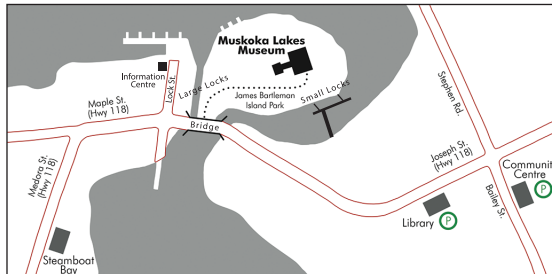
